


# Sustainable Development Goal 4 Target 7

# OSW overarching goal




By 2030, the UK education community\* ensures every learner receives an education that equips them to contribute to a just, sustainable, peaceful and resilient world through the realisation of SDG 4.7.

*This goal crosses over devolved and reserved areas of government policy. Education is fully devolved with separate systems in England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Our Shared World (OSW) is a coalition of stakeholders focused on the English context and will work in consultation with partners in Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales regarding UK-wide policy areas such as International Development.*

## OSW timeline part one:

2019

- **Apr:** Global Learning Network agrees to advocate for GCE under umbrella of SDG 4.7
- **Aug:** Oxfam GB and WWF-UK become first co-chairs
- **Aug & Nov:** first face-to-face meetings

2020

- **Jan:** working groups operational\*
- **Feb-Apr:** first whole-coalition Zoom calls
- **Mar:** OSW vision agreed, one-pager and song sheet created
- **Sep:** #RebootEducation film created by OSW partners\*\*
- **Oct-Dec:** first OSW review
- **Dec:** SEEd replaces WWF-UK as co-chair



## OSW timeline part two:



2021

- **Nov:** Did you COP that? online series begins


2022

# OSW principles



- Strong two-way communication
- Inclusion and valuing of diversity
- Regular direct engagement with young people and educators
- Use of critical, creative, collaborative and caring thinking
- Valuing and responding to feedback
- Prioritising our shared vision but also respecting the need for autonomy and independence
- Ensuring roles/responsibilities are clear and reviewed at least once a year
- Sharing a commitment to joint learning and supporting horizontal working
- Commitment to an iterative process in response to changing external environment over the next ten years
